

LAKER CLASSIC 2023 U11 AND U13 REP DIVISIONS

Tournament Rules

October 27-28, 2023

OMHA permit #11869

- 1. All OMHA playing rules apply.
- 2. Scores and standings will be kept up to date at the arena
- 3. All game are three(3), ten(10) minute stop time periods
- 4. Two-person officiating will be in place for all games
- 5. Each division will play in round robin games
- 6. Round robin standings will be determined by a point system
 - Win game 5 points
 - Tie game 3 points
 - Win period 2 points
 - Tie period 1 point
- 7. There will be no overtime until elimination games and championship games. If an elimination game is still tied after regulation, three on three, five-minute sudden death period. If the game is still tied, then there will be a three-person shootout. If the game is still tied, then sudden death shootout will be used to determine a winner. Teams can only use players once and must go through their lineup.
- 8. Ties in round robin standings will be broken in this order
 - 1- Head-to-head
 - 2- Most wins
 - 3- Fewer goals against
 - 4- Fewest penalty minutes
 - 5- Most goals for
 - 6- Coin flip
- An MVP will be selected by the opposing coach during each round robin game; and an MVP of the final game will be selected by a member of the minor hockey executive.

- 10. Medals will be presented for the final game to the champions and runners-up.
- 11. Teams are permitted one (1) timeout per game.
- 12. Teams must check in at the registration table located upstairs at least 30 minutes before each game. Coaches, assistant coaches and trainers must sign the game sheet before each game.
- 13. Teams are to be ready to go on the ice and start immediately when the Zamboni doors close.
- 14. Please ensure dressing rooms are left clean, no shooting pucks etc. in the hallways and rooms. Teams who leave dressing rooms dirty, unsanitary, etc. will be responsible for a cleaning fee of \$100.
- 15. Off ice warmups are permitted **OUTSIDE THE ARENA ONLY**. Due to lack of indoor space, off ice warmups in the arena are not permitted.
- 16. Games will be curfewed at 50 minutes to keep schedule.
- 17. All major, match or gross misconduct penalties will result in the player unable to play the rest of the tournament weekend.
